COMPLAINT IN EQUITY UNDER THE SUNSHINE

ACT

ORDER

AND NOW, this 2019, upon consideration of the Stipulation of the parties, it is hereby ORDRED and DECREED that:

- 1. The resolution enacted by the Allegheny County Board of Health at its advertised regular meeting on November 7, 2018, recommending that every child in Allegheny County, unless otherwise counseled by a physician, receive the HPV Vaccine (HPV Vaccine Resolution), is declared invalid, null, and void ab initio.
- 2. The stipulation is entered by the parties to settle and compromise a claim without admission of the validity or invalidity of such claim by either party.
- 3. This Order shall in no way limit the Allegheny Board of Health from taking any future action on recommendations, rules and/or policies regarding the HPV Vaccine nor shall it limit James Lyons-Weiler from taking any future action under the Pennsylvania Sunshine Act, 65 Pa.C.S.A. §§ 701-716.
- 4. Official Actions and Deliberations of a quorum of the Allegheny County Board of Health are subject to the Sunshine Act, 65 Pa.C.S.A. §§ 701 – 716.
- 5. The terms "Official Action" and "Deliberations" are defined by Section 703 of the Sunshine Act.

- 6. The Prothonotary shall mark the above-captioned matter as settled, discontinued and ended with prejudice.
- 7. The parties shall be responsible for their own costs and attorney's fees.
